SUBJECT: Notice of Intent to Debar Pursuant to HRS Chapter 103D,
Hawaii Public Procurement Code

Procurement Circular No. 2014-15, dated 10/01/2014, is replaced with this updated notice.

In accordance with **HRS §103D-702 and HAR chapter 3-126, Authority to debar or suspend**, the following firm will remain suspended by the Chief Procurement Officer (CPO) of the City & County of Honolulu until a debarment decision takes effect:

Pacific Landmark Group, Inc. (PLG)	12/08/2014	3 years

The City has completed its investigation and intends to debar PLG from any award of public contracts, for a period not to exceed three (3) years, pursuant to HAR §3-126-13, as a result of the concerns and deficiencies identified in the City's investigation. Therefore, bids or proposals will not be solicited and will not be considered for award from the person or firm during the

suspension period pursuant to HRS chapter 103D. However, this suspension does not preclude eligibility for listing as a subcontractor on bid awards.

Pursuant to §103D-702(g), CPO shall make written determination on any contract awarded prior to the effective date of the suspension; consequently, contracts awarded to PLG may remain in effect under applicable contract terms and conditions during the suspension period.

For Executive Departments, excluding DOE, UH, OHA and HHSC, existing contracts for PLG shall remain in effect under applicable contract terms and conditions during the suspension period.
