

## Capability Statement

1. **Core Competencies:** Headquartered in Kahului, Hawaii, Pacific Biodiesel Technologies was conceived in 1995 to recycle unmanageable quantities of waste cooking oil into biodiesel at the Central Maui Landfill. Always focused on our mission to promote a clean, sustainable energy future through the community-based production of renewable fuels, PBT has developed a multi-pronged agriculture strategy to produce local biofuel crops economically and increase in-state capacity for biodiesel production. PBT's newest 5.5 million gallon per year processing facility, Big Island Biodiesel, was commissioned in 2012 and features state-of-the-art advanced zero-waste processing technology and boasts the nation's highest quality biodiesel. While the bulk of production is available on Hawaii Island, biodiesel is also stored on Maui and Oahu, enabling PBT to provide in excess of 5,000 gallons per day bulk biodiesel delivery and retail biodiesel dispensing for 30 days, in the event of an emergency.

3. **Differentiators:** With almost two decades of experience in constructing and operating biodiesel plants, as well as producing and marketing quality fuel, PBT has industry leading accomplishments no other U.S. company can claim. Recently named Best Green Business in Hawaii, PBT is unique in that all biodiesel is produced on Hawaii Island at Big Island Biodiesel, with the bulk of the feedstock sourced in state.
