Prior to awarding this contract, the SPO verified compliance of the Contractor(s) named in the SPO Vendor List Contract No. 16-15. *No further compliance verification is required prior to issuing a contract, purchase order, or pCard payment when utilizing this contract.*

PURCHASING CARD (pCard). The State of Hawaii Purchasing Card (pCard) is required to be used by the Executive department/agencies, excluding the DOE, HHSC, OHA, and UH, for orders totaling less than \$2500. For purchases \$2500 or more, agencies may use the pCard, subject to its credit limit, or issue a purchase order.

PURCHASE ORDERS may be issued for purchases \$2,500 or more and for vendors who either do not accept the pCard, who set minimum order requirements before accepting the pCard for payment, or who charge its customers a transaction fee for the usage.

SPO VL Contract No. 16-15 AND MASTER AGREEMENT NO. MA16000234-2 (VWR International, LLC) shall be typed on purchase orders issued against this vendor list contract. For pCard purchases, the SPO VL Contract No. 16-15 and Master Agreement MA16000234-2 (VWR International, LLC) shall be notated on the appropriate transaction document.

GENERAL EXCISE TAX. The Hawaii General Excise Tax (GET) shall not exceed 4.712% for the island of Oahu and 4.166 % for Maui, Kauai and Hawaii. The GET is not applied to shipping or delivery charges.

PAYMENTS are to be made to the Contractor(s) remittance address. HRS §103-10 provides that the State shall have thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of invoice or satisfactory completion of contract to make payment. Payments may also be made via pCard.

LEASE AGREEMENTS are not allowed under this contract.

DELIVERY. Unless otherwise indicated in the Master Agreement, the prices are the delivered price to any Purchasing Entity. All deliveries shall be F.O.B. destination, prepaid and allowed (with freight included in the price). If there is a special case where inside delivery fee must be charged, the Contractor will notify the Participating Entity. Additional delivery charges will not be allowed for back orders.
