

RELATING TO PROCUREMENT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII

SECTION 1. The small purchase of services, §103F-405, Hawaii Revised Statutes, was established to provide purchasing agencies an expedited way to competitively procure health and human services for \$25,000 or less. Currently, the statutes requires purchasing agencies to follow the small purchase procedures in accordance with HRS §103D-305. Over the years, the small purchase limit for HRS Chapter 103D changed. Therefore, the disparity warrants HRS Chapter 103F to establish its own small purchase procedures.

SECTION 2. Section 103F-405, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

§103F-405 Small purchases. Purchases of health and human services of less than \$25,000 are small purchases, and shall be made in accordance with ~~[section 103D-305 and]~~ rules adopted by the policy board to implement that section.

SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
