**USE OF PRICE & VENDOR LIST CONTRACT BY NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS.** Pursuant to HRS §103D-804, nonprofit organizations with current purchase of service contracts (HRS chapter 103F) have been invited to participate in the SPO price and vendor list contracts.

**COMPLIANCE PURSUANT TO HRS §103D-310(c).** Prior to awarding this contract, the SPO verified compliance of the Contractor(s) named in the SPO Vendor List Contract No. 11-08. No further compliance verification is required prior to issuing a contract, purchase order or pCard payment when utilizing this contract.

**PURCHASING CARD (pCard).** The State of Hawaii Purchasing Card (pCard) is required to be used by the Executive department/agencies, excluding the DOE, HHSC, OHA, and UH, for orders totaling less than \$2,500. For purchases of \$2,500 or more, agencies may use the pCard, subject to its credit limit, or issue a purchase order.

**PURCHASE ORDERS** may be issued for purchases of \$2,500 or more and for Contractors who either do not accept the pCard, set minimum order requirements before accepting the pCard for payment or charge its customers a transaction fee for the usage.

**SPO VL CONTRACT NO. 11-08 AND MASTER AGREEMENT NO. 01910** shall be typed on purchase orders issued against this vendor list contract. For pCard purchases, the SPO VL Contract No. 11-08 and the NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement No. 01910 shall be notated on the appropriate transaction document.

**GENERAL EXCISE TAX.** The Hawaii General Excise Tax (GET) shall not exceed 4.712% for the island of Oahu and 4.166% for Maui, Kauai, and Hawaii. The GET shall be invoiced as a separate line item. The GET is not applied to shipping or delivery charges.

**PAYMENTS** are to be made to the Contractor(s) remittance address. HRS §103-10 provides that the State shall have thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of invoice or satisfactory completion of the contract to make payment. Payments may also be made via pCard.
