SUBJECT: Clarification of Governor's Emergency Proclamation, dated August 5, 2021, Exempting Internal Revenue Service (IRS) Tax Clearance

This amendment is to clarify the IRS "Not Compliance Status" in Procurement Circular 2022-04.

A Hawaii Compliance Express (HCE) certificate indicating a contractor's "Not Compliant" status **will be accepted** for final payment or contract award provided the vendor's status for the IRS is either "Pending" or "Submitted" **and** the status for the Hawaii Department of Taxation, Hawaii Department of Commerce & Consumer Affairs, and the Hawaii Department of Labor & Industrial Relations are "compliant" or "exempt".

If the IRS portion is "Not Compliant", the HCE certificate shall not be used for contract award or final payment.
