**COMPLIANCE PURSUANT TO HRS §103D-310(c).** Prior to awarding this contract, the SPO verified compliance of the Contractor(s) named in the SPO Price List Contract No. 21-18. No further compliance verification is required prior to issuing a contract, purchase order, or pCard payment when utilizing this contract.

**PURCHASE ORDERS** may be issued on an as-needed basis during the price list contract period. It is the responsibility of each agency to ensure the issuance of purchase orders is not placed with the Contractor after the price list contract expiration date. The contractor shall not accept orders after the price list contract expiration date.

**SPO PRICE LIST CONTRACT NO. 21-18** should be typed on purchase orders issued against this price list contract or notated on the appropriate transaction document.

**BASE UNIT PRICES** include delivery to destination and all other costs incurred, except the following applicable taxes:

1. The State General Excise Tax (GET) and County Surcharge shall not exceed the following rate if the contractor elects to pass the charges to its customers.

The GET or use tax and county surcharge may be added to the invoice as a separate line item and shall not exceed the current max pass-on tax rate.

County surcharges on State General Excise (GE) Tax or Use Tax may be visibly passed on but are not required. - 2. The GET shall be computed only on the Unit Bid Price or subsequently adjusted Unit Bid Price (hereinafter referred to as Adjusted Price, excluding the Federal Excise Tax (FET), State and County fuel oil taxes, and all other applicable taxes;
- 3. State and County fuel taxes as applicable to the appropriate County;
- 4. Federal LUST Tax;
- 5. Hawaii Environmental Response Tax;
- 6. Federal Oil Spillage Tax.

The Contractor shall list on the invoice the above taxes as separate line items to the base unit prices. The State of Hawaii is exempt from the FET on gasoline and diesel fuel.

#### FOR FEDERAL EXCISE TAX please note the following:

- 1. All gasoline and diesel fuel purchases from this price list contract are exempt from the FET. The FET shall not appear on the invoice.
- 2. The SPO will provide to the Contractor a *Federal Certificate of State or Local Government Use of Diesel Fuel and Gasoline* for the State of Hawaii. This document exempts the State of Hawaii from the FET for the state or government use of diesel fuel and gasoline. Any other form used for the FET must be approved by the SPO.

**PRICE ADJUSTMENT** shall be a pass-through cost from the Contractor's supplier to the State. For each price adjustment, the Contractor shall submit to the State Procurement Office, written documentation of the price increase or decrease from its supplier. The State reserves the right to contact the Contractor's supplier to confirm and substantiate all price changes that occurred during the contract period.

The Contractor shall notify the State Procurement Office, all price changes within twenty-four (24) hours of the effective price adjustment date. Price adjustment notices may be sent electronically or by facsimile to the State Procurement Office.

**E-10 UNLEADED GASOLINE IN HAWAII.** Gasoline shall meet the specifications for automotive spark-ignition engine fuel as approved by the Measurement Standards Branch of the Hawaii State Department of Agriculture. The sale, distribution, and transportation of petroleum products specified herein shall comply with all current Federal, State, and County laws and ordinances rules and regulations or as revised thereafter.

**ULTRA LOW SULFUR DIESEL AND ULTRA LOW SULFUR DIESEL DYED** shall meet the specifications for diesel fuel oils as approved by the Measurement Standards Branch of the Hawaii State Department of Agriculture.

The sale, distribution, and transportation of petroleum products specified herein shall comply with all current Federal, State, and County laws and ordinances rules and regulations or as revised thereafter.

**DELIVERIES.** Delivery of gasoline and diesel fuel to the various agencies of the State and Counties shall be coordinated by the Contractor with each agency's delivery location. The agency shall notify the Contractor, with a minimum of a twenty-four (24) hour notice to schedule a delivery of bulk gasoline or diesel fuel. A shorter lead time must be agreed upon by both parties. Another alternative is for the Contractor to coordinate a delivery schedule with each user agency that specifies the day and time that is agreed upon by both parties.

Prior to delivery, the Contractor shall contact the agency to coordinate the delivery arrangements.

The Contractor is required to deliver all items outstanding at the end of the contract period on orders received during the term of the contract.

**PAYMENTS** are to be made to the remittance address of the Contractor. HRS §103-10, HRS, provides that the State shall have thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of invoice or satisfactory completion of the contract to make payment.

**COMPLIANCE PURSUANT TO HRS §103-53.** All state and county contracting officers or agents shall withhold final payment of a contract until the receipt of tax clearances from the director of taxation and the Internal Revenue Service. This section does not apply to contracts of less than \$25,000.
