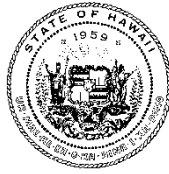

USE OF PRICE & VENDOR LIST CONTRACTS BY NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS. Pursuant to HRS §103D-804, nonprofit organizations with current purchase of service contracts (HRS chapter 103F) have been invited to participate in the SPO price & vendor lists contracts.

A listing of these nonprofit organizations is available at the SPO website: <http://spo.hawaii.gov>. Click on *For Vendors > Non-Profits > Cooperative Purchasing Program > View the list of qualifying nonprofits eligible to participate in cooperative purchasing*.

If a nonprofit wishes to purchase from a SPO price or vendor list contract, the nonprofit must obtain approval from each Vendor, i.e., participation must be mutually agreed upon. A Vendor may choose to deny participation by a nonprofit. Provided, however, if a nonprofit and Vendor mutually agree to this arrangement, it is understood that the nonprofit will retain its right to purchase from other than a SPO price or vendor list contractor(s).

Agencies are cautioned that the remittance address on an invoice may be different from the address of the vendor code annotated on the purchase order.

COMPLIANCE PURSUANT TO HRS §103D-310(c). Prior to awarding this contract, the SPO verified compliance of the Vendor(s) named in the SPO Price List Contract No. 25-07. *No further compliance verification is required prior to issuing a contract, purchase order, or pCard payment when utilizing this contract.*

PURCHASING CARD (pCard). The State of Hawaii Purchasing Card (pCard) is required to be used by the Executive departments/agencies, excluding DOE, SFA, HHSC, OHA and UH for orders totaling less than \$2,500. For purchases of \$2,500 or more, agencies may use the pCard, subject to its credit limit, or issue a purchase order.

Note: Vendors may impose a transaction fee, not to exceed 4%, for pCard transactions.

PURCHASE ORDERS (PO) may be issued for purchases \$2,500 or more and for Vendors who either do not accept the pCard or set minimum order requirements before accepting the pCard.

SPO PL CONTRACT NO. 25-07 & SOURCEWELL CONTRACT NUMBER (notated on the vendor information page) shall be typed on purchase orders issued against this price list contract. For pCard purchases, the SPO PL Contract No. 25-07 and the Sourcewell Contract Number shall be notated on the appropriate transaction document. The Sourcewell Contract Number can be found on the vendor information page.

PAYMENTS are to be made to the Vendor(s) remittance address. HRS §103-10 provides that the State shall have thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of invoice or satisfactory completion of contract to make payment. Payments may also be made via pCard.

COMPLIANCE PURSUANT TO HRS §103-53. All state and county contracting officers or agents shall withhold final payment of a contract until the receipt of tax clearances from the director of taxation and the Internal Revenue Service. This section does not apply to contracts of less than \$25,000.

STATE GENERAL EXCISE TAX (GET) AND COUNTY SURCHARGE shall not exceed the following rates if seller elects to pass on the charges to its customers.

SCOPE

The contract allows for self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) and breathing air systems with related equipment, including:

- A. Self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) such as:
 - i. Closed-circuit systems, facepieces, cylinders, backpacks, regulators, and, rapid intervention crew/company universal air connection (RIC UAC);
- B. Breathing air compressor and compressor systems, including mobile and stationary fill stations, cascade systems, purification, and storage systems;
- C. Related equipment and accessories to the extent that the offering is ancillary or complementary to products listed above such as:
 - i. Personal alert safety systems (PASS), SCBA storage, brackets, cabinets and holders, respiratory protection, wildland, purifying respirators, replacement parts and accessories, mask fit tester, decontamination cleaning systems, RIC bags, and;
- D. Related services to the extent that it is ancillary or complementary to the equipment described above such as:
 - i. Testing, servicing, maintenance, service and maintenance- breathing air compressors, testing – cylinder hydrotesting, SCBA service maintenance, Mask fit testing.

AGENCY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Registration on Sourcwell is not required.
2. Agency shall reference the Sourcwell Contract No. 011824-LNC (for L.N. Curtis & Sons).
3. Agency shall obtain a quote from L.N. Curtis & Sons.
